**ASSISTANT / ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR**

(Design Studio & Support Courses / Tenure-Track / One or More Positions)

The Department of Interior Design at Louisiana State University invites applications and nominations for one or more tenure-track Assistant/Associate Professor positions, beginning in the Fall of 2009.

LSU is the state's comprehensive research institution with an enrollment of approximately 30,000 students. The state's flagship university is located in the capital city, 70 miles from New Orleans. It is the gateway to a culturally rich region of Louisiana. Baton Rouge has a newly invigorated downtown; with an award winning performing arts center, museums, restaurants, galleries, and parks close to campus. The College of Art and Design is comprised of the Department of Interior Design and the Schools of Art, Architecture, and Landscape Architecture. Interior Design has 7 full time faculty positions and several adjunct instructors serving 200 majors. Entrance into the Interior Design program is by a competitive, selective admissions process. The program is CIDA accredited, and has ranked consistently in the top 15 university programs of Interior Design by DesignIntelligence, and the Almanac of *Architecture and Design Schools*.

**Required Qualifications:** Terminal degree in Interior Design or related professional graduate degree; professional experience; evidence of, or the potential for, teaching effectiveness, scholarship, creativity, communications skills and collegiality. The applicant should demonstrate accomplishment in interior design excellence and have a focused interest in design theory, contemporary interior issues and topics.

**Additional Qualifications Desired:** One degree in the discipline of Interior Design; extensive, quality, professional experience; professional licensure or eligibility for the NCIDQ; LEED accreditation.

**Responsibilities:** To expand the respected Interior Design program, the successful candidate must be able to teach in the design studio sequence and other studio/seminar/lecture courses identified within the Interior Design curriculum.

Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications. An offer of employment is contingent on a satisfactory pre-employment background check. Application deadline is February 27, 2009 or until a candidate is selected.
